

Homework and Quizzes:

Homework and some quizzes will be assigned on *MyMathLab*. Homework assignments can be done an unlimited number of times until the due date and the highest grade will prevail. Quizzes can be taken 3 times before the due date and the highest grade will prevail. In class quizzes may be given with or without notice. Quiz problems will be based directly on the homework.

MyMathLab:

An access code will be given to you in the first week of class. You need to register at the website <http://www.coursecompass.com>. You will need our **course number: santoro56452**. When you register, you will make up a user name and password, which you will use each time you login. You can submit your work from any computer where you can get online and login.

The email address you register with is the one I will use to communicate with you so *if you change your email address, YOU MUST let me know!*

Assignments must be done by their due date!! After the due date you will not be able to work on quizzes at all anymore. Incomplete homework may still be completed but will lose 15% for each day it is late. Uncompleted work will be assigned a grade of 0!! I will go over homework problems in class so if you get stuck on one at home, be sure to ask about it in the next class. You can also email me with questions.

If you think you have entered a correct answer and the computer doesn't seem to recognize it, email it to me and I can log on and check it. If your answer is correct, I will give you the credit for it SO PLEASE DO NOT GET FRUSTRATED !!

Make up Policy:
